During the next few months, I was working my tail off with the help of my great team. I was blessed to attend NTC 2006 St. Louis. Little

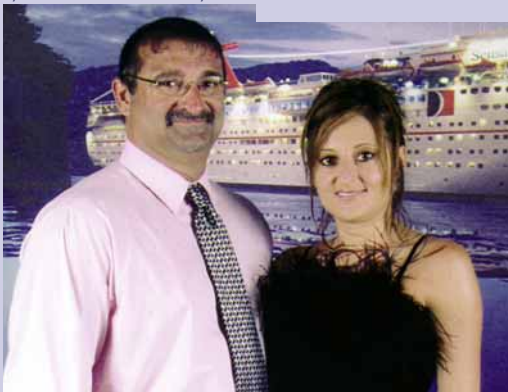

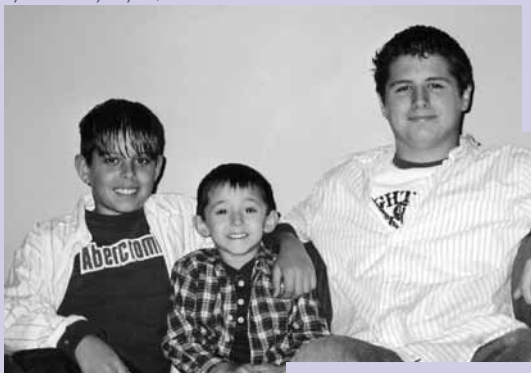
