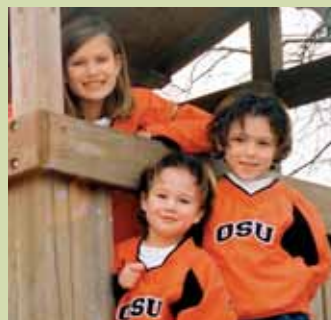
over 100 invitations for her business launch the next weekend. Thanks to her help, I went into qualification that month for AM.
